Just a few fun facts about Ford's flathead V8 -- It didn't become popular until after WWII because it was no match for an overhead 4-banger with similar cubic inches. After the V -8's could be made much bigger than their older brothers, they started to take over. Model B's could easily be bored out to 220cu. inches and many were bored and stroked to 239 inches, the same size as Mercury came out with in 1939.
