For those who love hats, our supplier is offering them for \$12.00 (any color) with the Club logo on the front. And of course, the car imprinting on your own shirt is still available.



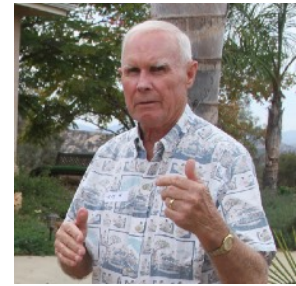

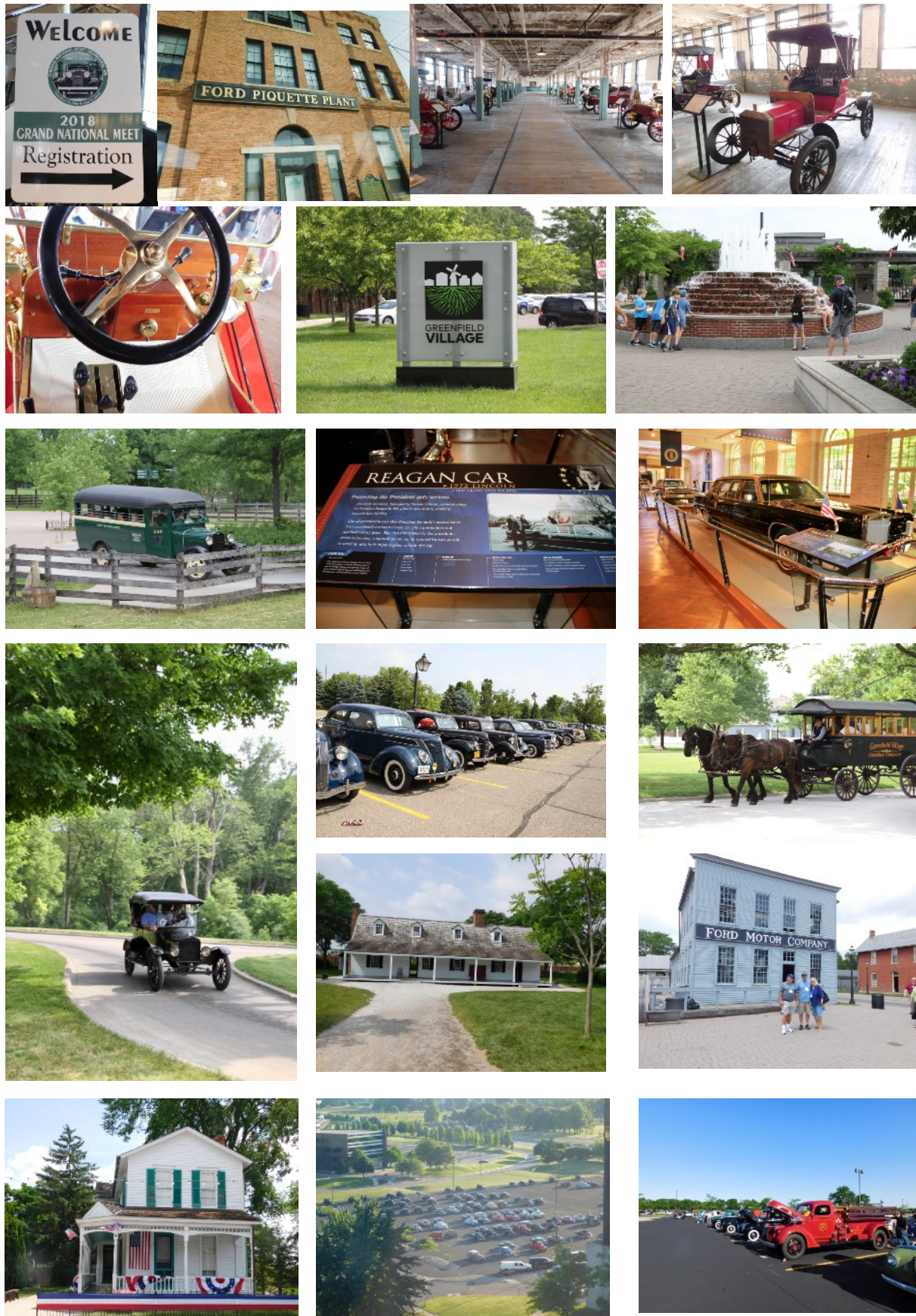

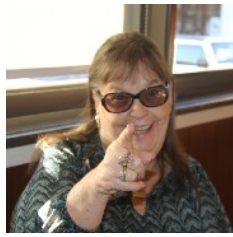
