UPDATE!



Restoration Projects

As far as restorations or work on early Ford V-8s, specifically, we have not worked on one in quite a while. We are always working on Ford Model As and Ts and a few overhead valve Fords from the 50s and early 60s, but the flathead V-8 Fords elude us for projects. Six years ago we did some mechanical work on a 1942 Ford two-door sedan, but that is the last one on a Ford vehicle. We do, however, have a 1929 Lincoln V-8 and 1936 Lincoln V-12 that we have been working on and using within the program the last two years. Note: significant time and resources are being allocated to the restoration of a 1953 Mercedes-Benz 300 S, which we hope will be selected to compete at the 2023 Pebble Beach Concours.

Red Wrench Club – Shop Equipment

Below is our short list of items that we have on the *Red Wrench* wish list. We are in the process of refreshing this list, since one of our *Red Wrench Club* donors recently stepped forward to fund nearly all the tools and supplies on our 2021-22 wish list.

\$2,000 – one item that we are working towards securing is a backup sewing machine for our trim and upholstery area. At this time we have 10 machines, one for each student, so there is always a worry if something breaks.

With students always in the process of learning, accidents happen all the time. We would like to buy a new machine that matches many of our others and take one of the older (1970s) machines out of circulation and have it tuned-up as a spare. The new machines cost about \$1,800 plus shipping; the service charge on the spare machine will cost about \$150, plus any parts.

\$450 – another option that would appeal to the funding interests of your club is the completion of our Flathead Ford run stand engine. We were donated a 1936 Ford V-8 a few years ago and we have been working to include it as one of our demo engines for both the engine rebuild class and the tune-up and diagnostic classes. We are short several parts to get it in circulation in the classes, primarily ignition and carburation parts.

Vehicle Donation

Over the last six years, we have been able to start building a permanent collection of cars for the restoration program and McPherson College. Most cars we receive are used within the program for several years and then sold to help fund the next round of projects and education. However, as we have been receiving donations of vehicles that are of important historical value, either mechanically or design wise, we have been adding them to the college's endowment to be saved in perpetuity for future students to learn from. This includes vehicles like our 1953 Mercedes 300 S, 1936 Lincoln, 1963 Avanti and 1965 Porsche 356.

With both the engineering importance and the social/historical significance of the Ford Flathead V-8, especially the pre-war cars, we would like to be able to add one to our permanent collection to be used for teaching demonstrations. Would the club or a club member who own such vehicles, consider donating one to McPherson College?

The ideal candidates for this are cars that can be fully operational with minimal work. Most of these are older restorations that are quite presentable, but are maybe starting to show their age. We will go through the cars mechanically in classes and often do light cosmetic work. Then, we really like to be able to use the cars with students. It is amazing how many students grow up with a passion for "old" cars but have not been able to experience them running, driving or even riding in them, especially pre-war cars of any kind. These are the kind of experiences that stick with the students and help them decide what direction they will go within the industry, not to mention build morale for young people that sometimes feel "stuck" in Kansas.
